<p><b><u>ENGLISH</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 3 pack of Post-it notes</li> <li>• Folders for handouts</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>SCIENCE</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1- 1.5 inch or larger three ring binder, loose leaf paper, pens, pencils, highlighters, TI-30 or TI-84 calculator (the one you will need for math class), colored pencils</li> <li>• <b>AP Bio, AP Chem, Physics:</b> Composition notebook</li> </ul>
<p><b><u>MATH</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• For all classes - A 1½ inch or larger three ring binder, loose leaf paper, pens, and pencils</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Calculators:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>General Math, Pre-Algebra, Algebra 1 and Geometry</b> - Please purchase a TI-30 calculator</li> <li>• <b>Algebra 2, Pre-Calculus, AP Statistics or AP Calculus</b> - Please purchase a TI-84 CE calculator</li> </ul> <p>**If you are starting out in Algebra 1 or Geometry and will eventually take higher math courses, purchase the calculator for Algebra 2 and higher.</p>	<p><b><u>SOCIAL STUDIES</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Global Studies:</b> Pencils, pens, notebook, folders. Recommended: 2" binder</li> <li>• <b>Accelerated Global Studies:</b> 2- 2" binders, 2 sets of 6 dividers, 100-sheet notebook, pen/pencil, highlighter, 1 pocket folder</li> <li>• <b>US History Survey:</b> Pencils, pens, notebook, folders. Recommended: 2" binder</li> <li>• <b>AP European History, AP United States History:</b> 2 - 1" three ring binders, 2 - sets of 5 dividers, set of 4 highlighters, 100 sheet notebook, pen/pencil</li> <li>• <b>Comparative Religions, Democracy, Economics, Sociology, WI Studies:</b> 50 page notebook, Section in a 3-ring binder, pen/pencil</li> <li>• <b>Psychology:</b> 100-sheet notebook, pocket folder, pen/pencil</li> <li>• <b>AP US Government:</b> 1 - 2" binder, 1 set of 5 dividers, headphones, notebook, highlighter, pen/pencil.</li> </ul>
<p><b><u>FOREIGN LANGUAGE</u></b></p> <p>Foreign Languages require a notebook dedicated to the language and a folder/and or binder. Expo dry erase marker encouraged for personal use during activities.
