ABOUT CAVOC

The School District of Rhinelander owns 1,200 acres of managed forest land, the largest school forest in the State of Wisconsin. The forest is managed by the School Forest Advisory Committee (SFAC), which is comprised of educators, community members, and local business representatives. One of the largest tracts of land within the 1,200 acres is the Cedric A. Vig Outdoor Classroom (CAVOC) at 160 acres.

The Rominsky Lodge was constructed by the Rhinelander High School Building Trades Class during the 1980's. The facility was remodeled and updated in 2012 when the School Forest Environmental Education Center (SFEEC) was built by the Rhinelander High School Building Trades Class.

The Lu Berndt Active Learning Center, and the Northwoods Animal Museum were added to the lower level in the fall of 2017. Children can explore and create in a hands on classroom.

The Kinder Forest was completed in 2018 and provides a playscape for families with young children. Children can dream and explore in an outdoor environment created especially for the young child.

CAVOC FACILITIES

The 3,500 square foot SFEEC provides the unique opportunity for a multitude of activities which include environmental education for all School District of Rhinelander grade levels. Each year, all SDR students in 4K through 8th grade spend at least one day at CAVOC. High School students visit CAVOC as schedules allow. The CAVOC curriculum provides for both outdoor and indoor activities. Some of these are:
