Recommended: 2" binder • Accelerated Global Studies: 2- 2" binders, 2 sets of 6 dividers, 100-sheet notebook, pen/pencil, highlighter, 1 pocket folder • US History Survey: Pencils, pens, notebook, folders. Recommended: 2" binder • AP European History, AP United States History: 2 - 1" three ring binders, 2 - sets of 5 dividers, set of 4 highlighters, 100 sheet notebook, pen/pencil • Comparative Religions, Democracy, Economics, Sociology, WI Studies: 50 page notebook, Section in a 3-ring binder, pen/pencil • Psychology: 100-sheet notebook, pocket folder, pen/pencil • AP US Government: 1 - 2" binder, 1 set of 5 dividers, headphones, notebook, highlighter, pen/pencil.
<p><u>FOREIGN LANGUAGE</u></p> <p>Foreign Languages require a notebook dedicated to the language and a folder/and or binder. Expo dry erase marker encouraged for personal use during activities.
